Our Commitment

The Minnesota Bonsai Society offers a Bonsai Legacy Program to help ensure that the trees of our members are respectfully re-homed when needed. Whether through placement with another member or others in the community, our goal is to keep these trees alive, thriving, and appreciated.

How It Works

- **Planning Ahead**: Members may choose to include the Minnesota Bonsai Society in their estate planning documents or simply keep this document with their personal records.
- If Assistance Is Needed: At the time when bonsai trees need to be re-homed, family, friends, or caretakers can contact the Minnesota Bonsai Society.
- **Re-Homing Process**: Our volunteers will work with the family to:
 - Assess the collection.
 - o Identify suitable new caretakers within our community.
 - Arrange for transportation or pickup, when possible.
 - o Ensure that the trees are passed along with respect and continuity of care.

Next Steps for Members

- Keep this document with your important papers.
- Inform your family, personal representative, or trustee that the Minnesota Bonsai Society may be contacted if your trees need re-homing.
- If desired, reach out to us in advance to discuss your collection and your wishes.
